

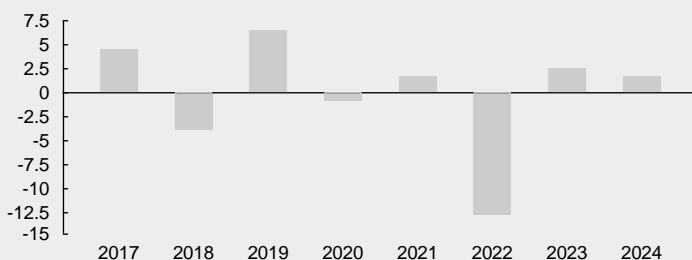

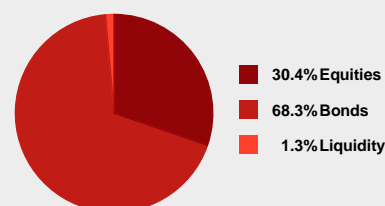
Investment Goal

Yearly performance in %



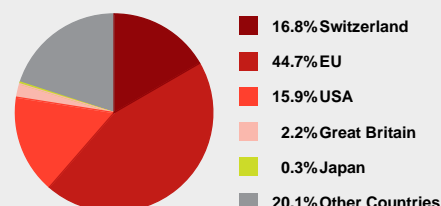

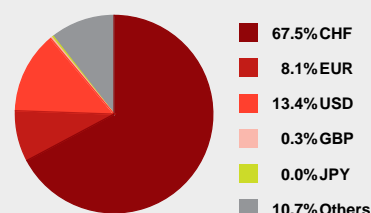
